

Geocaching in Marion County



Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location. Geocaching promotes getting outdoors and exploring your surroundings. You never know what you might discover, right here in your own town! Geocaches can be easy or difficult to find, depending on their size. Geocache containers can be hidden anywhere, so you may have to look high and low.
