Anybody up for waves and whitewater? East Marion Veterans Memorial Park has a playground, game courts, a dog park, trails, and best of all, a wave pool and slide! For something wilder, head to Valley Falls State Park for an afternoon of powerful whitewater on the Tygart Valley River.

Marion County also has games ashore. There's disc golf at Morris Park in Pleasant Valley, putt-putt at the quirky Coal Country Miniature Golf in Fairmont, and an outdoor shooting range at Dents Run Wildlife Management Area in Mannington. You can hunt and fish there, too. Other highlights include hikes and camping at Curtisville Lake and Campground in Mannington.

That's just a preview. Convenient and accessible, Marion also makes the perfect basecamp! We're the middle of everywhere. Davis, a prime destination for Nordic and downhill skiing, is just two hours away. We're also close to Tygart Lake State Park in Grafton and Coopers Rock State Forest in Bruceton Mills. tep through an open gateway to the past. Journey to Marion County, where heritage is a natural resource! You're invited to share the wealth, here and throughout our "middle of everywhere" region.

Pricketts Fort State Park in Fairmont is a great place to start. The recreated encampment conjures the 18th century with costumed interpreters, historic trades, and colorful events. Prefer a later era? The Barrackville Covered Bridge is the site of an 1863 Civil War skirmish.

Hamilton Round Barn in Mannington is another treasure. Built in 1911, the landmark originally served as a dairy barn and was home to the first electric milking machine in Marion County. The West Augusta Historical Society now owns the barn and operates it as a museum; visit to see a collection of antique farm equipment, early mining tools, and other West Virginia artifacts.

There's so much more to explore, too. Heritage overflows our borders to places like Arthurdale, America's first New Deal settlement, and Philippi, where you can see real mummies. And see The Robinson Grand — a fully restored 1913 theater — in Clarksburg.

BARRACKVILLE COVERED BRIDGE

This 1853 gem is the second oldest covered bridge in West Virginia. It was almost destroyed by a Confederate general in 1863. Fortunately, locals convinced him to spare it.

WOODLAWN CEMETERY

Fairmont's historic burial ground has several Civil War figures and veterans, including Frances Pierpont, the "Father of West Virginia."

FAIRMONT SUSPENSION BRIDGE

When Confederate General Jones' men attacked the city (and its railroad) in 1863, they left behind bullet holes in the piers. Look for the marker on Madison Street.

THE FLEMING HOUSE

Aretas Brooks Fleming was the eighth governor of West Virginia and the prosecuting attorney for Marion County during the Civil War. His home is located at the intersection of Jefferson Street and Washington Street in downtown Fairmont.

A. Brooks Fleming House 🛞

220 Jefferson St., Fairmont

This marks the home of the eighth governor of West Virginia, Aretas Brooks Fleming. He was a former prosecuting attorney for Marion County who lived from 1839 - 1923. The marker is located on the grounds of the former American Legion Post.

Attack on Fairmont (%)

Madison St., Fairmont

At the foot of the Fairmont suspension bridge, Confederate Gen. William E. Jones watched on April 29, 1863, as his men attacked Fairmont to destroy the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Bridge at present-day 12th Street. The bullet-pocked bridge piers can be seen to this day.

Barrackville Covered Bridge (**)

Barrackville

Located in Barrackville, off U.S. Rt. 250 N, County Rt. 21 at the junction of 250/32.

Originally built in 1853 by West Virginia's pioneer bridge builders Eli and Lemuel Chenoweth, this 148-foot single lane bridge is an example of a modified Burr Truss in near original condition. On April 29, 1863, the bridge was almost destroyed during the Jones-Imboden Raid, but the Ice family, nearby mill owners and Confederate sympathizers, convinced Confederate Gen. William E. Jones to leave the structure.

Battle for the Bridge (*)

Water St., Fairmont

The marker is located at Palatine Park, at the junction of Everest Drive (east) and Water Street. Part of the Jones-Imboden Raid, the largest battle of the Civil War in northern West Virginia was fought in Fairmont. The battle of the suspension bridge took place on April 29, 1863, at the

site of the Palatine Foundry. The

bridge (1852 - 1908) spanned the Monongahela River between Fairmont and Palatine. fairmontstate.edu

Beverly-Fairmont Turnpike ⊕

117 Benoni Ave., Fairmont

As part of the 1863 Jones-Imboden Raid, Confederate Gen. William E. Jones attacked the B&O Railroad Bridge, riding by the turnpike on April 29, 1863. This is the northern end of the Beverly-Fairmont Turnpike, a gravel road completed in 1852.

Fairmont State University

1201 Locust Ave., Fairmont 304.367.4000

A one-room schoolhouse preserves and honors Fairmont State University's earliest origins, when it opened in 1865 as a private teacher training school.

The university's Hardway Hall is the birthplace of three international educational drama honorary organizations: Alpha Psi Omega (1925) for four-year colleges, Delta Psi Omega (1929) for two-year colleges, and the International Thespian Society (1929) for high schools.

Father's Day Church

301 Fairmont Ave., Fairmont 304.366.3351

Feel the historical significance of Father's Day at Central United Methodist Church, the descendant church of Williams Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church, where the first observance of Father's Day was held on July 5, 1908.

Francis H. Pierpont Home (**)



The marker is located at the City of Fairmont Public Safety Building parking plaza (right end at the entrance).

Francis H. Pierpont, Governor of the Restored Government of Virginia and the "Father of West Virginia," brought his bride, Julia Augusta Robertson Pierpont, to this home in 1854. Pierpont devised plans that restored loyal Virginia to the Union, giving life to West Virginia.

Frank & Jane Gabor West Virginia Folklife Center

1201 Locust Ave., Fairmont 304.367.4403

Located on Squibb Wilson Boulevard on the campus of Fairmont State University, the Frank & Jane Gabor West Virginia Folklife Center is dedicated to the preservation and perpetuation of our region's rich cultural heritage. Featured here are libraries, exhibits, educational programs, festivals, and performances.

Gold Star Mothers Memorial

35 City View Terrace, Fairmont

The Gold Star Mothers Memorial can be found in East Marion Veterans Memorial Park. The bronze plaque lists the names of local mothers who have lost their children during military service.

Graves of the Pierponts (%)

335 Maple Ave., Fairmont

Francis H. Pierpont, Governor of the Restored Government of Virginia and the "Father of West Virginia," died on March 24, 1899. He is buried here with his wife, Julia Augusta Robertson Pierpont, among many other notable citizens. The marker is located at the entrance to Woodlawn Cemetery Historic District.

Hamilton Round Barn

338 Flaggy Meadow Rd., Mannington 304.986.7053

Built in 1911, the barn originally served as a dairy barn and was technologically significant for its impact on farming by incorporating the first electric milking machine in Marion County.

The West Augusta Historical Society maintains ownership of the barn, operating it as a museum. The museum holds a collection of antique farm equipment, a carriage, a sleigh, early mining tools, and other West Virginia artifacts.

The barn is also available to rent for weddings, reunions, and other events.

May - September

Korean War Memorial

1201 State St., Pleasant Valley

Also at East Marion Veterans Memorial Park Complex, the Korean War Memorial honors the 27 soldiers from Marion County that gave their lives. There are two flagpoles at 27 feet high as well as a flag that stands at 125-feet, or 38 meters — a reference to the 38th parallel along which Korea was divided during the war.

Mannington Vietnam Veteran Memorial

Corner of Mead Ave. & Water St., Mannington

The Mannington Vietnam Veteran Memorial honors those Mannington residents who served and were killed in the line of duty in Vietnam from 1959-1975. It was dedicated by Vietnam Veterans of America Robert A. Clark Chapter 1055.

Maple Grove Cemetery

819 Morgantown Ave., Fairmont

Established in 1808, the Maple Grove Cemetery is the final resting place of veterans from the Revolutionary War, the War of 1812, the Civil War (both Union and Confederate), the Spanish American War, World War I, World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War.

Marion County Courthouse

Corner of Adams St. and Jefferson St., Fairmont

Designed by Yost & Packard of Columbus, Ohio, this Beaux Artsstyled building was completed in 1900. The building's dome is capped by a classical figure holding the scales of justice. The Sheriff's Residence (now the Marion County Historical Society & Museum) is adjacent to the Courthouse and includes the old jail.

The interior features three magnificent murals on the third floor. One depicts David Morgan of the famous Morgan clan fighting Native Americans; the others have a focus on industry and agriculture in the area. Externally, classical ornamentation includes the Corinthian order for the series of fluted columns supporting the porticoes. Within the tympanum are decorative figures of scales, an eagle with outstretched wings, a mining car, a shovel, and a male figure representing justice, power, agriculture, and mining.

The club provides a collection of family histories, census records, cemetery records, county histories, and more from the local area, West Virginia, and surrounding states. The club meets in the Genealogy Room at the Marion County Public Library. mcpls.org/departments/genealogy

Marion County Historical Society & Museum

211 Adams St., Fairmont 304.367.5398

Built in 1912, the former home to the county sheriff now serves as a museum featuring exhibits related to the state's past such as the compass used to survey present-day West Virginia. Tours of the museum and old jail are available. A small gift shop features books written by local authors, glassware, and Marion County playing cards. Special events are held throughout the year.

Marion County Military Veterans Plaza

Corner of Adams St. & Madison St., Fairmont

The plaza honors our veterans with a bronze statue of soldiers from WWI, WWII, Korea, and Vietnam. Three marble monuments list the names of Marion County veterans, with the front dedicated to those killed in action while serving their country. Located in the heart of historic downtown Fairmont, events take place at the plaza throughout the year.

Marion County Vietnam Veterans Memorial

35 City View Terrace, Fairmont 304.363.2969

Located at the entrance to East Marion Veterans Memorial Park, this six-ton monument is etched with the names of the 27 men from Marion County who died in Vietnam. The murals surrounding the monument depict the various branches of the military. Additionally, the memorial features a Huey Helicopter that was flown in Vietnam, the Purple Heart Memorial, and the Gold Star Mother Memorial.

Marion County Visitor Center

1000 Cole St., Pleasant Valley 304.368.1123

Restructured from the former Marion County Children's Shelter, the Marion County Visitor Center has a rich history. Standing tall since 1941, the original building was one of the state's Works Progress Administration's (WPA) final projects. When the historic site was in the pathway for the construction of the Gateway Connector, the efforts to preserve it beaan.

The building wasn't sound enough to be moved in its entirety, but with the help of the Federal Highway Administration, the carved stone of the exterior was saved. The structure was pulled apart, chiseling out each piece, stone by stone, and re-built to welcome visitors to Marion County. The building now houses the offices of the Convention & Visitors Bureau of Marion County and Marion County Parks & Recreation Commission.

We know, that's a lot of work. But being proud of Marion's heritage is at the heart of our mission, and we were glad to be able to preserve a little piece of history from this place we hold so dear.



Pricketts Fort State Park

88 State Park Rd., Fairmont 304.363.3030

This nationally registered historic site was originally built in 1774 as a refuge fort on the western Virginia frontier. Reconstructed in 1976, today costumed interpreters recreate 18th century lifestyles through demonstration of colonial crafts.

Also on the property is the 1859 Job Prickett house that illustrates the development of an increasingly civilized lifestyle through an 85-year span.

A Visitor Center with Orientation Gallery and Museum Gift Shop are open year-round free of charge. Tours of both structures and special events are offered in season. Self-guided audio tours are available during the off season.

Purple Heart Memorial

35 City View Terrace, Fairmont 304.363.2969

Located at the entrance of East Marion Veterans Memorial Park beside the Marion County Vietnam Veteran Memorial and Huey Helicopter.

The Purple Heart Memorial honors individuals from north-central West Virginia who were wounded or killed in action from any war.

Robert H. Mollohan-Jefferson St. Bridge

Jefferson St. Bridge, Fairmont

After undergoing a restoration amounting to \$23.5 million, this "Million Dollar Bridge" reopened on October 27, 2000. Originally opened to traffic in 1921, the bridge was one of the earliest reinforced concrete arch bridges in the country and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Crossing the Monongahela River, rail lines, and city streets, the 1,266-foot structure is three graceful arch rings designed by the Concrete Steel Engineering Company of New York. It was built by the John F. Casey Company of Pittsburgh. HMdb.org



The Coal Mines of Marion County

Marion County's rich history is etched with the coal mining legacy that shaped the region. While the coal industry brought prosperity, it also brought heavy sacrifices. The Monongah Mine Disaster of 1907 claimed 361 lives, forever marking the landscape with the Monongah Mine Disaster Memorial and Bell, along with the Monongah Heroine Statue. In 1968, the Farmington Mine Disaster shook the community, leaving 78 miners lost. Their memory endures at Mannington, where the monument stands atop the No. 9 Mine's unrecovered portion, now a hallowed cemetery. Telephone Museum

Wilson School Museum

915 E. Main St., Mannington 304.986.7053

Once an elementary school in Mannington, the building is now a museum under the direction of the West Augusta Historical Society. The museum features the original bed, chair, and dresser of Francis H. Pierpont, the "Father of West Virginia." Visitors will also see mountain musical instruments, early school exhibits, and relics of Bower's Pottery.

Adjacent to the museum is an 1870 log cabin originally built in Wetzel County by George Washington Price. The log cabin is restored and furnished with authentic items of the era. Visitors can also see a Chessie System caboose built in 1912 as well as a 1900's South Penn Oil Co. Gasoline Station.



Along with walking, hiking, and running, rail trails are favorites for bicycling (on pavement), on-leash dog walking, roller/inline skating, skateboarding, cross-country skiing, and snowshoeing as well as wildlife observation.

Joel McCann Memorial Trail - Mannington

The Joel McCann Memorial Trail in Mannington follows the former Baltimore & Ohio (B&O) Railroad line. The 1.3-mile packed limestone rail trail follows along Buffalo Creek through downtown Mannington and is named after one of the city's longtime fire chiefs. The trail links with the North Marion Senior Center Walking Trail. A trailhead with a bathroom and outdoor fitness center is at Water Street and Mead Avenue.

MCTrail - Fairmont

The Marion County Trail – better known as the MCTrail – begins near Pricketts Fort State Park and continues for 2.5 miles along Pricketts Creek through rural Marion County. At Pricketts Fort, you can connect with the Mon River Trail South to continue into Morgantown or Caperton Trail North to reach the Pennsylvania state line and a future connection with the Sheepskin Trail on the other side of the border. A highlight of the paved trail is the 1914 Meredith Tunnel, a 1,200-foot-long lighted tunnel that runs under Speedway Ave. and Suncrest Blvd. approximately 1/4 mile into the trail.

Mon River Trail - Fairmont

This 29-mile rail trail meanders along the Monongahela River from the WV/PA state line through Monongalia County into Marion County at Pricketts Fort State Park. In 2020, the Mon River Rail-Trail system became an inductee into the Rail-Trail Hall of Fame. The Mon River Trails Conservancy maintains the trail.

West Fork River/Ralph S. Larue Trail - Monongah

The West Fork River Trail is 14.5 miles long and is located in rural Marion and Harrison Counties. The trail features three bridges and runs between Fairmont, Monongah (site of the December 6, 1907, mine disaster), Everson, Worthington, Hutchinson, and Shinnston. There is access to the river and beaches (great for fishing and boating), small pavilions and flower planters along the trail. Several historical features including old coke ovens, mine works, and bridge piers can be seen. Visitors will also find interactive interpretive markers.

Worthington Park/Rail Trail Access

Travel Rt. 19 S. from Fairmont, going through Monongah and Worthington. Turn left at the fire department, and then turn left at the bridge. This beautiful, 10-acre waterfront park offers fishing, picnicking, a playground, and a softball field as well as basketball and horseshoe courts. Restrooms are also available.


